1. The bronze rigidly complies with the specifications of the U. S. Bureau of Standards, i.e.:

85% copper

5% zinc

5% lead

5% tin

- The copper content is VIRGIN copper, and not scrap metal, so-called copper alloys or "mixes," or "re-melts."
- 3. The castings are made by the French-sand process, and are heavy, solid castings of the finest quality, free from pits, blow-holes, and minute cracks.
- 4. The work is hand-tooled (or chased) by master craftsmen, the very best of the skilled artisans whose services have been secured from a conscientious combing of the U. S. A. (This chasing is necessary to remove small particles of bronze which adhere to the castings when they are withdrawn from the sand moulds, and to give sharp, clear definition.)
- 5. The work is invariably and without exceptions OXIDIZED (not painted or otherwise "doped") to insure the long life of the background coloring. Borders, letters and other raised portions are burnished to a high gloss, after which the work receives not less than four coats of finest transparent lacquer to preserve the finish.
- All work is in all respects EQUAL TO THE FINEST produced anywhere.
